

**Q. How much water is wasted with a dripping faucet?**

A. This is a great question, for example if a faucet is leaking about 30 drips per minute. Your system would be leaking approximately 4 ½ gallons of water per day, 130 gallons of water of water per month and approximately 1,575 gallons of water per year. All that from one dripping faucet!
